The Mace

The mace is a traditional symbol used to communicate and designate authority. With echoes of historical use as a weapon of offense against armored knights, the academic mace represents education's ability to break through ignorance and prejudice.

The Southern College mace was crafted in 1986 by John Durichek, an alumnus who is now associate professor of computer science and technology at his alma mater.

The mace was designed to represent Southern's heritage and its *raison d'être*. The base is of pine from Jones Hall, built in 1917 and razed in 1985. The main staff is of walnut. The seven rings represent completeness. The four-sided segment is seen as Southern's underlying educational philosophy — balanced mental, spiritual, physical, and social development for each student.

Bearing the mace and leading the procession is the grand marshal, Katie Lamb, associate professor of nursing. Her regalia is of green trimmed in white, the college colors.
