Gordon Bietz became the 25th president of Southern Adventist University's in 1997 and retired after 19 years in May 2016. Under his leadership, enrollment increased by more than 1,200 students to 3,500, and facilities experienced record renovations to accommodate that growth.

Before accepting the position as president at Southern, Bietz pastored the 2,300-member Collegedale Church of Seventh-day Adventists and served as president of the Georgia-Cumberland Conference

His retirement is a "working retirement." Besides his part-time job as director of Higher Education for the North American Division, Bietz continues to serve as director of the Adventist Association of Colleges and Universities and fulfills speaking appointments for the world church.

He and his wife, Cynthia, have twin daughters who each have provided them with three grandchildren. Retirement gives them opportunity to spend more time connecting with their family.

Due in part to his successful leadership at Southern, Bietz is in high demand as a speaker at workshops and seminars all across the country. But no matter where his travels take him, he always comes back home to Southern!

T H E M A C E



The mace is a traditional symbol used to communicate and designate authority. The Southern Adventist University mace was crafted in 1986 by John Durichek, a Southern alum. Southern’s mace represents its heritage and *raison d’être* (reason for existence). The base is of pine from Jones Hall, built in 1917 and razed in 1985. The main staff is of walnut. The seven rings represent completeness. The four-sided ebony segment is seen as Southern’s underlying educational philosophy—balanced mental, spiritual, physical, and social development for each student. The brass flames represent the Holy Spirit.

Bearing the mace is the grand marshal, Keith Snyder, chair of the University Senate and chair of the Biology and Allied Health Department. His regalia is evergreen, the university’s traditional color.

P R E S I D E N T ' S A W A R D F O R T E A C H I N G E X C E L L E N C E

A lifelong educator, **Kathy Goddard** joined the English Department at Southern in 2010 to teach composition and creative writing. She earned her undergraduate degree at Andrews University in Michigan and master's degree at John Hopkins University in Maryland and received the Zapara Award for Excellence in Teaching and the Alumni Academy Achievement Award.

A native of Brazil, Pratt sponsors the Latin American Club on campus as well as the Psychology Club. Her professional affiliations include the American Psychological Association, the International Honor Society in Psychology, the Society for Industrial and Organizational Psychology, and the Society for Human Resource Management.

P R E S I D E N T ' S A W A R D F O R E X C E L L E N C E I N S C H O L A R S H I P

After graduating from Pacific Union College in California with a bachelor's degree in biology, **Aaron Corbit**, PhD, planned to pursue a career in medicine. Instead, God led him to teach science and math at a small church school in Chicago, Illinois. Later he returned to the West Coast to complete his doctorate in biology at Loma Linda University, focusing his research on rattlesnake conservation biology and the epidemiology of snakebites in Southern California. He joined Southern's Biology Department in 2012.

Described by his peers as an "amazing biostatistician" and "exemplary researcher" who is "perpetually helpful," Corbit not only publishes his own research but also evaluates student and faculty research projects and analyzes the data of others. He is hands-on in conducting research with and lending guidance to many students, including those who are pursuing a biology research degree as well as senior students in other academic disciplines. "Always open and willing" to assist, he is constantly "helping someone with his or her data."

"Aaron sets a high standard of excellence and demonstrates how and why research is such an integral part of ensuring that relevant and significant practices are used in the classroom," notes a fellow professor. "His willingness to go above and beyond normal requirements really sets him apart as a scholar scientist."

Another biology professor who frequently teams up with Corbit for research cites Corbit's major contributions to multiple publications in just the past two years with more work already underway. Recent projects include looking at the defensive behavior of black widow spiders and assessing the impact of human traffic on wildlife abundance in hiking trail systems. Conservation biology, behavioral ecology of venomous animals, and the intersection of science and faith are his broader research interests.

Acknowledging his own research accomplishments and his gift of helping students while holding them to exceptional statistical analyses, Southern Adventist University is pleased to present Aaron Corbit with the President's Award for Excellence in Scholarship.



Ben Thornton, PhD, joined Southern's faculty in 2010 and holds degrees in biology, conservation biology, and environmental toxicology. Recognition for his work is noted as "long overdue," and peers describe him as going "above and beyond" and embodying "what excellence in scholarship is all about."

Thornton's research with students has included differential protein expression during limb regeneration in lizards, atrazine-induced changes in glutathione transferase activity, detection of microplastics in sea turtles, dendrochronology on White Oak Mountain, effects of MCHM from coal mining on fathead minnows, and detection of estrogen in wastewater effluents.

With the support of colleagues, Thornton envisioned and implemented the first undergraduate research program for Southern's biology students. As biology research coordinator, he established courses for a research degree, created an undergraduate research lab, and wrote the Biology Writing Guide to standardize writing requirements for both classes and research.

Thornton also serves as director of the Southern Arboretum and was the driving force behind this initiative, tagging specimens across campus while creating a website database for identification. To date, 1,200 trees and woody plants and 84 species (53 native) are catalogued and showcased, offering visitors an organized source of information about the aesthetic beauty and nature surrounding campus.

Additionally, Thornton has mentored students on Southern's Evangelistic Resource Center mission trips to the Philippines, Zambia, and Zimbabwe and during international biology field classes. His photography is used to promote future trips as well as various departments' efforts and achievements.

With great esteem for his defining leadership in biology research, Southern Adventist University is pleased to present Ben Thornton with the President's Award for Excellence in Scholarship.

Krystal Bishop, EdD, has served as a professor in the School of Education and Psychology and director of the Teacher Education Program since 1996.
