Ignited for God's Purpose

Does your daily time with God move you to be used by Him for a purpose greater than yourself?

It's not a bad thing to go to God daily for comfort, encouragement, or hope, seeking to be rooted in your identity in Him and understanding your value comes from the One who saved you.

But what if this is just a starting place? My Bible tells me that while there is room for us to come to God with these needs, there's also room for us to be ignited by His Spirit to be used for His glory!

As Martin Luther King Jr. exhibited with his life, how does God want to move you beyond what can easily become a self-centered religion to a self-less faith? So often we can critique this institution or that organization for not doing enough to meet the needs of the people we see around us who are suffering or facing oppression. While God can and does use a variety of entities to work for His purposes, He wants to ignite *you*.

As you keep the Main Thing, the main thing this week, may you grasp hold of God's vision for your life to be able to serve others well and reveal the goodness and love of Christ to those who are longing to see Him.

Prayer:

Jesus, you said in Acts 1:8 that "I would receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon me," so I'm asking you today to baptize me with your Spirit so that I "do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with [you]," oh God, and make a tangible difference in the world around me.

Reflections:

- Ask God in prayer to reveal to you a specific person, group of people, or need that He is wanting to equip you to serve.
- What person, group of people, or need do you already feel a strong passion for? Perhaps this is where God's purpose for your life begins.
- What did MLK Jr. have to give up in order to further his life of service? What might you have to give up in order to fulfill God's purposes for your life? What do you have to gain by being ignited by God for His purposes before your own?
