# LIBRARY OFFERS FACULTY SELECT

Utilize Open Education Resources to help drive textbook affordability and access

Over the course of a year, the average college student spends more than \$1200 on books and materials (College Board, 2019). *EBSCO's Faculty Select* allows faculty members to directly support textbook affordability efforts. By leveraging free open materials and low-cost library-licensed resources, faculty can transform their courses and reduce the cost burden for students.

Through a single interface, faculty can search and access quality open textbooks, Open Educational Resources (OER), and request access to unrestricted library e-books from top academic publishers. Moreover, because Faculty Select consolidates Open Educational Resources (OER) in one database, it saves faculty time searching and collating materials from numerous OER platforms.

Social Explorer helps researchers gain deep insights into any area of interest - down to a city block, with stunning visualizations and built-in data. This tool helps you research with reliable and accurate location data.

### Included Content

Social Explorer includes the entire US Census (1790 to 2010) and the American Community Survey (2005 to 2018). Specilized US Resources include FBI Uniform Crime Reports, election results, religious membership studies, carbon emissions data, business patterns, and county health rankings.

Internationally, Social

*Explorer* includes census data from several countries, World Development Indicators, and population data.

### Guides and Videos

Social Explorer provides indepth guides and videos on using maps and reports through their Help Center.

This database is available on the library's A to Z database list. To access the library's databases by subject, click here. A link to this database can be included on any course research guide for easy student access.






