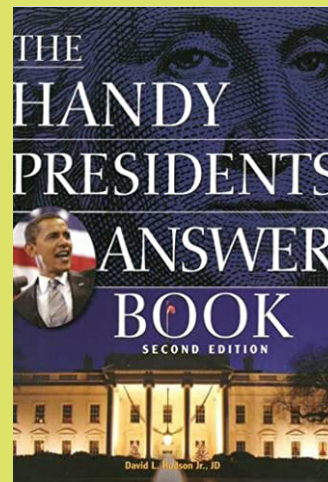
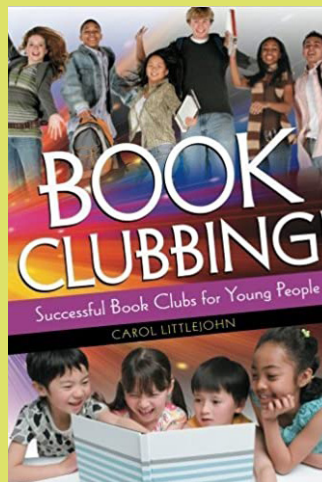
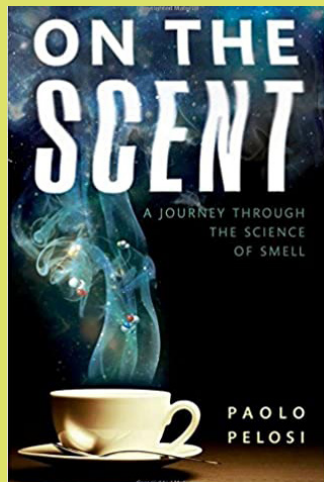
Teach Us All: Segregation for a New Generation

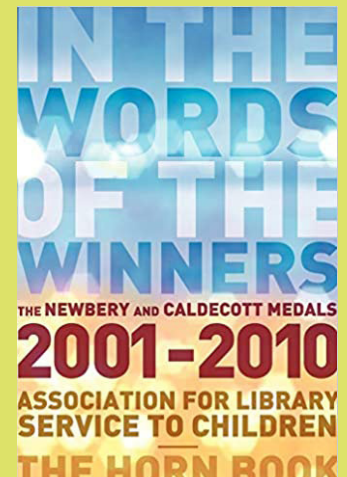
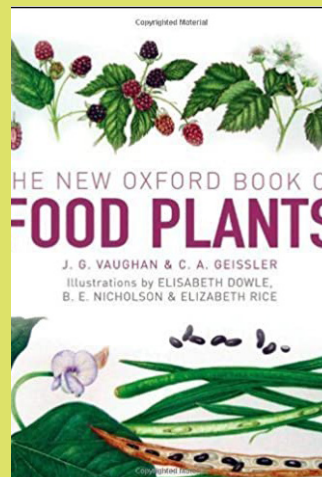
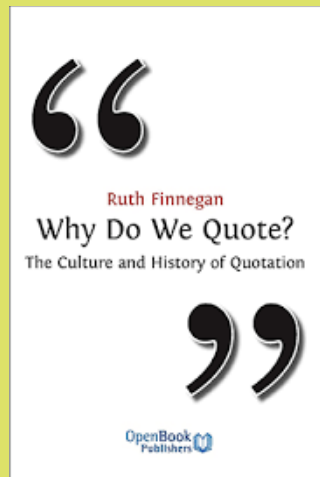
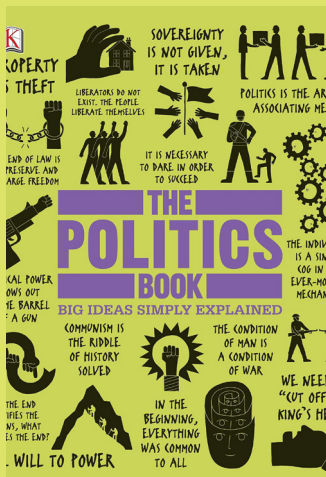
You can search all our eBook collections simultaneously by going to the Library's homepage and conducting a search for your title or topic. On the left side of the search results screen,

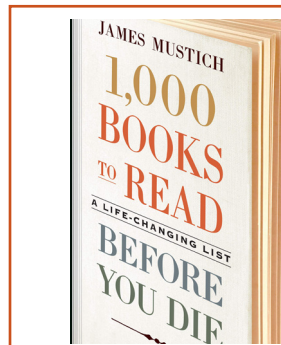




