## REFWORKS

*Newly adopted bibliographic management tool for university*

### Research Guide

The RefWorks guide includes directions on how to create an account, and links to a series of tutorials covering all aspects of using RefWorks. The FAQ page addresses questions you might have about this transition.

As you consider transitioning from Mendeley to RefWorks, keep in mind that although the library will only be providing

access and instruction to RefWorks, Mendeley is a free program. As such, your account will remain active with Mendeley as long as you would like to use the program. You can import your Mendeley library into RefWorks using these directions.

## PSYcARTICLES

*PsycARTICLES* is the premier peer reviewed database for psychology and behavioral sciences.

*PsycARTICLES* contains more than 150,000 articles from 110 journals - 50 published by the American Psychological Association (APA) and its imprint, the Educational Publishing Foundation (EPF).

This database includes all journal articles, book reviews, letters to the editor,

and errata from each journal. Nearly all APA journals go back to Volume 1, Issue 1, with some journals dating back to 1894.

### Searching in *PsycARTICLES*

With the EBSCO interface, *PsycARTICLES* provides familiar search options. This database is one of the few that allows researchers to limit to a certain methodology, which is extremely helpful in isolating

specific type of studies.

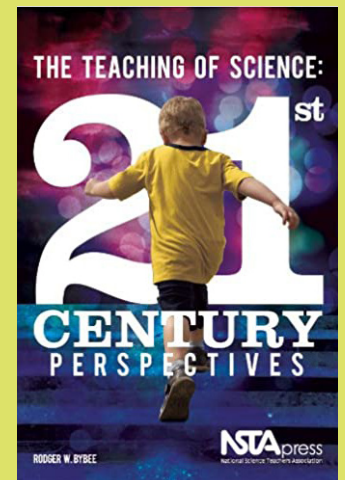
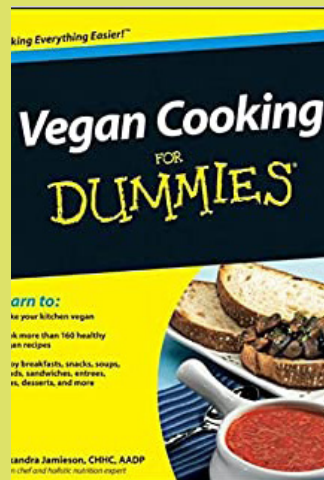
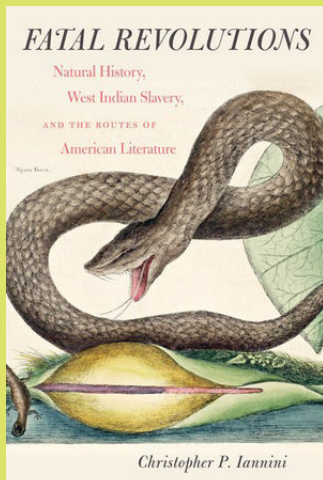
Additionally, users can search using the APA Thesaurus of Psychological Index Terms, available in the top toolbar.

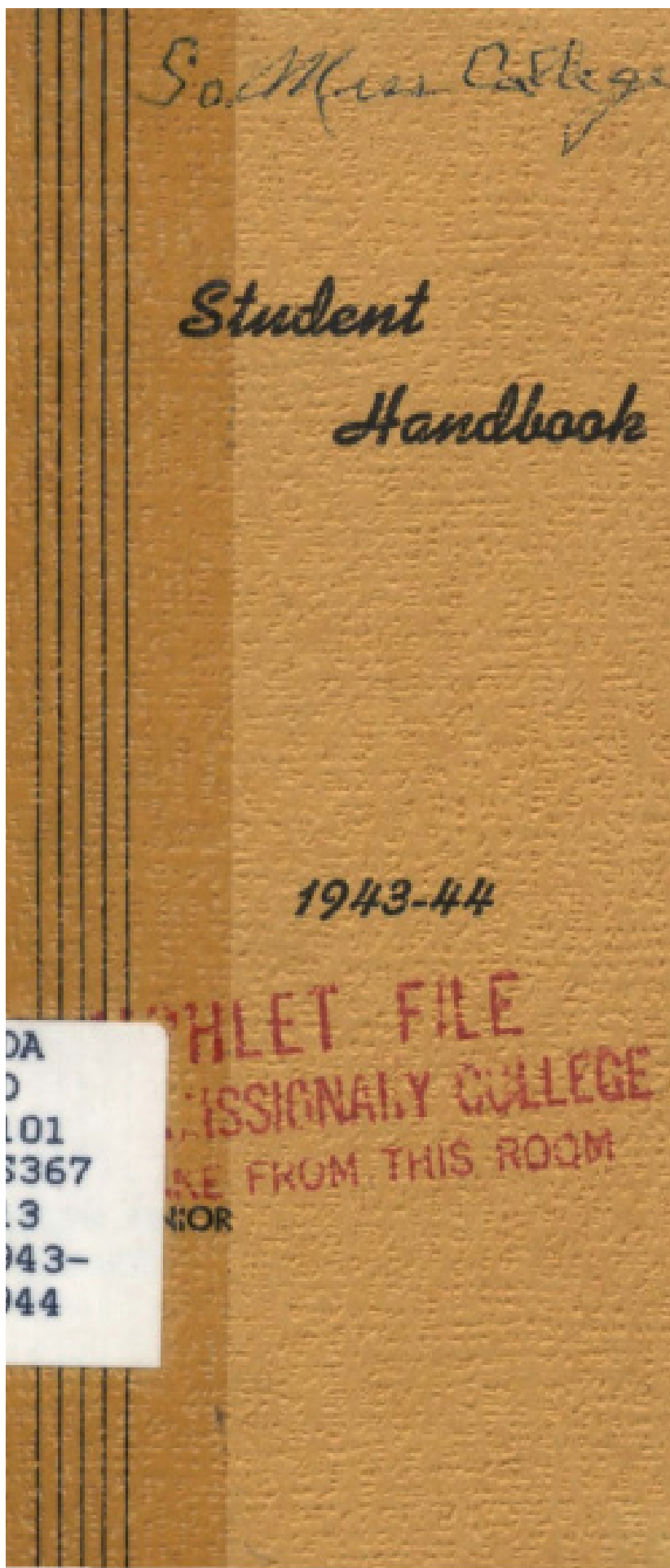
## About the Handbooks
