We are proud to welcome Bethany Howard to the McKee Library team. Bethany will serve as the public services librarian. This vital role leads the library's instruction team, chairs



Did you know McKee Library provides research guides on specific topics? These guides, covering major historical events, people, or topics, provide students with a location to research the given topic and access highquality materials.



This typed transcription of William Hanna's diary and military papers, compiled and edited by Dr. R.C. Slater of La Salle, Illinois in 1960, is part of McKee Library's Thomas Memorial Collection. contains over 2,700 volumes. An online finding aid is available on our website. This aid details the collection's arrangement and include information for researchers about how to access and cite the collection.

About the Collection

The Thomas Memorial Collection contains materials related to Abraham Lincoln and the Civil War. Dr. Vernon L. Thomas, along with Dr. Russell C. Slater and John W. Fling, Jr., contributed books, photos, periodicals, and other memorabilia concerning Abraham Lincoln and the Civil War. The collection was opened to the public on July 4, 1976.
