Students will find thousands of award-winning films, including Academy®, Emmy®, and Peabody® winners. Faculty will find frequently used films for classroom instruction, plus newly released films and previously unavailable archival material. The collection represents content from over 800 leading distributors, producers, and filmmakers.

In addition, AVON supports the entire range of curriculum. Some of the subjects covered include American history, world history, anthropology, Asian studies, art & architecture, African American studies, business & economics, classical music, cooking,

About the Collection



Dr. Vernon L. Thomas, along with Dr. Russell C. Slater and John W. Fling, Jr., contributed books, photos, periodicals, and other memorabilia concerning Abraham Lincoln and the Civil War. The collection was opened to the public on July 4, 1976.
