ARTSTOR

ArtStor features millions of high-quality images and media from some of the world's top photo archives, museums, libraries, scholars, and artists, including rare materials not available anywhere else. ArtStor's collections also include Open Access collections from partner museums freely available to all. All content in ArtStor is rights-cleared for education and research — you are free to use it in classroom instruction, handouts, presentations,

student assignments, and other noncommercial educational and scholarly activities.

With approximately 300 collections composed of over 2.5 million images (and growing), scholars can examine wide-ranging material such as Native American art from the Smithsonian, treasures from the Louvre, and panoramic, 360-degree views of the Hagia Sophia in a single, easy-to-use resource. ArtStor also supports

study across disciplines, including anthropology from Harvard's Peabody Museum, archaeology from Erich Lessing Culture and Fine Art Archives, and modern history from Magnum Photos. In addition, unlike results from Google or other search engines, images from ArtStor come with high-quality metadata from the collection catalogers, curators, institutions, and artists themselves.

About the Yearbooks

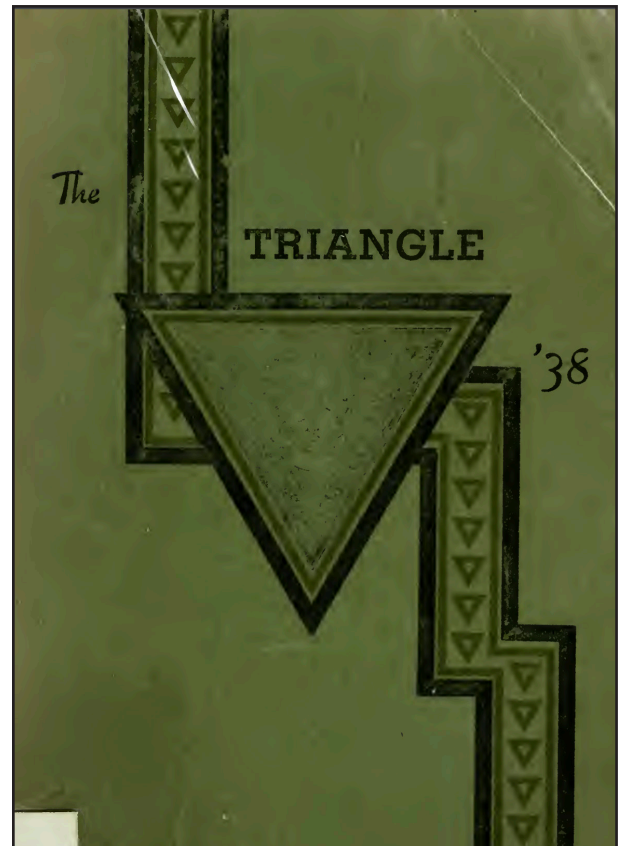
Southern's first yearbook, *The Southland*, was published in 1923. There were no yearbooks published from 1931 through 1937. The yearbook's name was changed to *The Triangle* in 1938. It received its current name, *Southern Memories*, in 1945. The *Southern Memories* (1953 to present) yearbooks have not yet been digitized. We are missing the 1930 yearbook.
