Southern Accent Covers Collegedale "News Desert"

Over the past few years, the students working for the *Southern Accent*, the student-led newspaper on Southern's campus, have been covering news stories about Collegedale, showcasing their commitment to keeping the community informed.

The undertaking is part of a national initiative where college and university students help cover "news deserts," which are areas the local news may not reach. According to a study by the University of Vermont, Collegedale does not have consistent news coverage and falls into the "news desert" category. The closest newspaper is the Chattanooga Times Free Press.

"When I moved to Collegedale six years ago, I noticed a gap in local news coverage, largely due to the downsizing of legacy news organizations," says Alva Johnson, associate professor in Southern's School of Journalism and Communication and faculty sponsor of the *Accent*. "This created an opportunity for our students to provide a valuable public service while honing

Beginning in 2020, with the help and direction of Johnson, the student newspaper widened its scope from campus to Collegedale. Student writers for the *Accent* were each given a Collegedale beat, and the stories were then published in the *Accent*.

"We added two extra pages to the student newspaper specifically for Collegedale news and received positive feedback from the community," says Johnson.

Last school year, the *Accent* won the Associated Church Press Award of Excellence for investigative reporting on the Collegedale train derailment. The *Accent* continues to be a part of the national initiative and writing for the Collegedale community.
