Collaborative Floor Guidelines

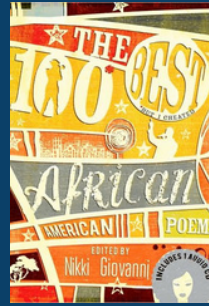
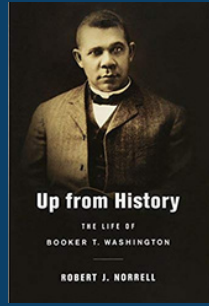
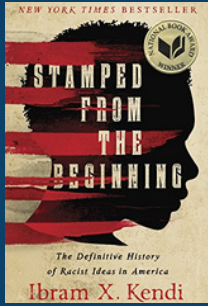
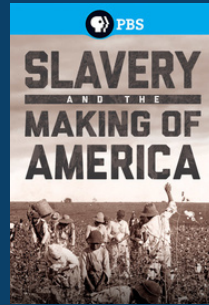
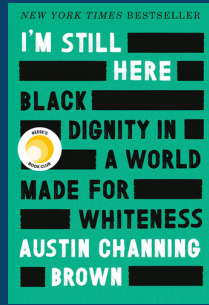
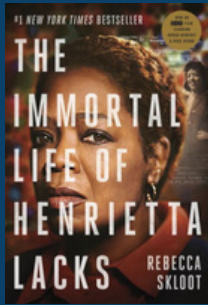
