Quiet Floor Guidelines

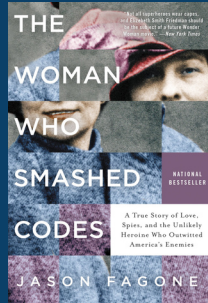
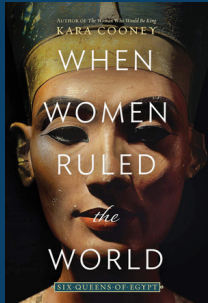
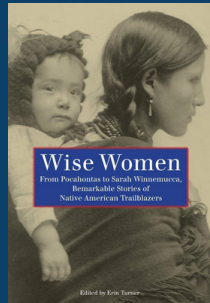
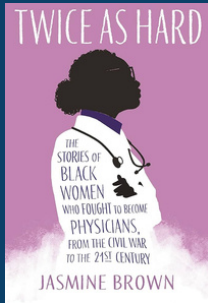
To ensure a quality study environment for all McKee Library patrons, we are enforcing several guidelines regarding the usage of the quiet floor.
