McKee Library offers online access to thousands of magazines through Libby, an online reader created by Overdrive. Sign in using your SAU username and password at libbyapp.com to begin checking out your favorite magazines. Some popular choices include The New Yorker, National Geographic, Reader's Digest, Kiplinger's Personal Finance, and Food Network Magazine.

The library also offers access to a few magazines through *Flipster*, an online reader created by EBSCO. Starting in March, *Flipster* will have access to *The Atlantic, Forbes,* and *Fortune*. You can access *Flipster* titles by searching for the magazine title on the McKee Library's homepage.


