DEATHS

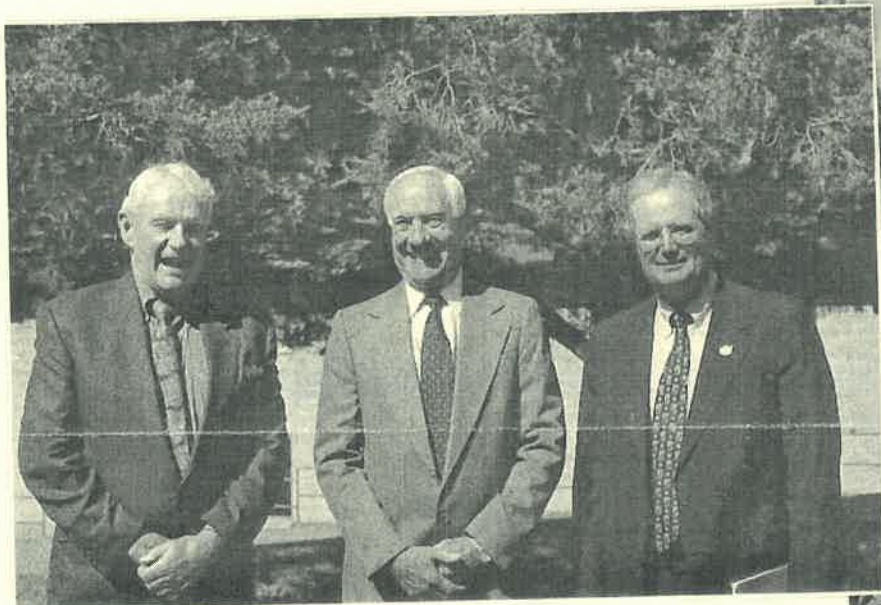
