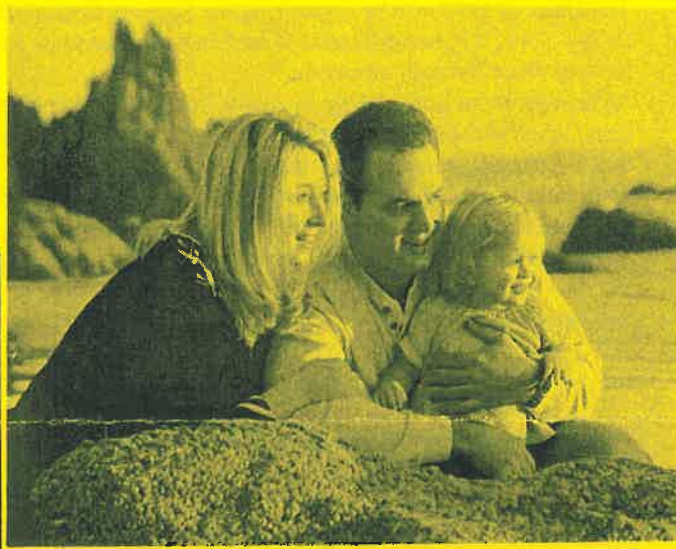
Joshua Luc, 7 lbs. 11 oz, bon April 22, 2002, to DEBBI (FREY)'92 and Travis Crowson.
