Valentine's Day Event

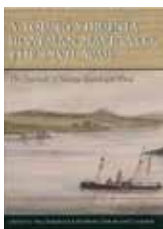
Mark your calendar for the annual Valentine's Day card making station from February 3 - 14 on the library's main floor.
