The library will be open March 4 & 6 from 9 am to 5 pm and March 9 from 6 to 11 pm during spring break.

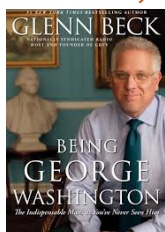

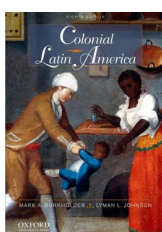

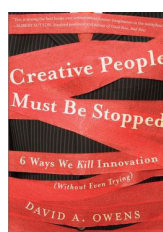
